St. Paul's Food Pantry

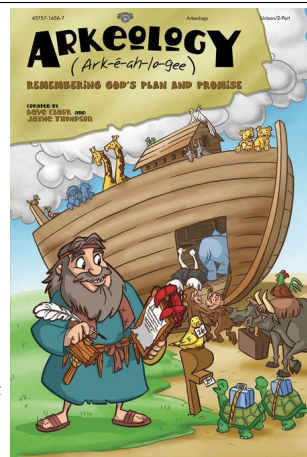
