Coffee Hour

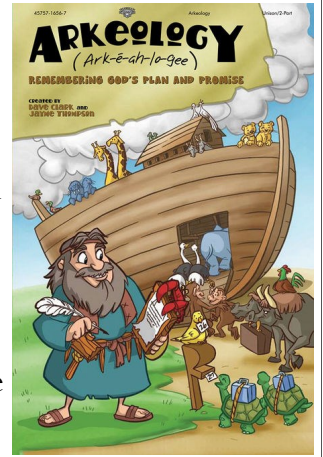
